

Bylaw No. 4-2007.

A BYLAW OF THE VILLAGE OF LAIRD TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 1-2002 WHICH PROVIDES FOR FIXING WATER AND SEWER RATE CHARGES.

WHEREAS the council of the Village of Laird has passed Bylaw No.1-2002 on the 13th day of September, 2002, which provides for the fixing of the rates to be charged for the use of water and sewer in the municipality; and

WHEREAS it is deemed desirable that the bylaw be revised;

NOW, THEREFORE, Council of the Village of Laird , in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Clause 10 is repealed and the following substituted therefore:

"Accounts shall be due when rendered. If rates are unpaid after 60 days from date of mailing, service shall be discontinued without notice, and shall only be reconnected upon full payment of utility account in arrears and a \$100.00 reconnection fee."

2. THE rates, charges, tolls or rents contained in this bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of approval being issued by the Local Government Committee.
