GENERAL PENALTY BYLAW

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Village of Laird in the Province of Saskatchewan, under the provision of Section 381 of *The Municipalities Act*, enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
- 2. "Municipality" means the Village of Laird.
- 3. Section 4 shall apply only to the infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction:
 - a) in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b) in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
- 5. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of the third reading and adoption.

Read a first time this 15th day of October, 2020. Read a second time this 15th day of October, 2020. Read a third time and adopted this 15th day of October, 2020.
