## BYLAW 2020 - 08 A BYLAW TO REQUIRE CRIMINAL RECORD CHECKS WITH NOMINATION FORMS

The Council of the Village of Laird in the province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

- Every candidate for Municipal office shall obtain a current (not more than 30 days), Criminal Record check at their own expense.
- Form B.1 (Results of Criminal Record Check for Candidates for Election) of The Municipalities Regulations must be included with and form part of the completed Nomination Form submitted by the candidate for municipal office. The criminal record check issued by the RCMP shall also be included with and form part of the completed Nomination Form submitted by the candidate for municipal office.

## **Bylaw in Effect**

1. This Bylaw shall come into force immediately.
