VILLAGE OF LAIRD BYLAW NO. 88 - 4

Laird, Sask.

A BYLAW TO REGULATE ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LAIRD.

The Council of the Village of Laird in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. In this bylaw:
 - (a) "all terrain vehicle" means all terrain vehicle as defined in The All Terrain Vehicles Act.
 - (b) " street" means any surveyed or other commonly used roadway, including alleys, within the Village of Laird.
- 2. A person is authorized to operate an all terrain vehicle on any street within the Village of Laird.
- 3. A person shall operate an all terrain vehicle on any other land within the Village of Laird only with the permission of the landowner.
- 4. A person shall operate an all terrain vehicle within the Village of Laird only between the hours from 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 P.M.
