VILLAGE OF LAIRD BYLAW #2014-7 A BYLAW TO AMEND A BYLAW

The Council of the Village of Laird in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

That Bylaw #45 respecting establishing a recreation board is amended.

- 1) In section #1, by striking out "LAIRD RECREATION BOARD" after "There shall be appointed by the Council a Recreation Board which shall be known as", and substituting "LAIRD CULTURE AND RECREATION BOARD".
- 2) By striking out section #3 and the following substituted: #3) "The Council shall appoint Recreation Board members from the residents of the Village and/or surrounding district as needed, with one Recreation board member acting as secretary".
- 3) By striking out section #4
- 4) By striking out section #5
- 5) In section #6 by striking out "for the remainder of the term" after "If any member of the Recreation Board absents himself for the meetings of the Board for a period of THREE (3) consecutive regular meetings, unless excused by resolution of such Board in session, or his seat becomes vacant by death, resignation or otherwise, then on being notified by the Recreation Board that such seat has become vacant, the Council shall forthwith appoint or re-appoint a person to fill such vacancy".
- 6) In section #8 by striking out "Chairman or" after "All orders and proceedings of the Recreation Board shall be entered in books to be kept for that purpose and be signed by the"
- 7) By striking out section #11
- 8) In section #12 by striking out "The Recreation Board may hold special meetings at the call of the Chairman" after "The Recreation Board shall meet in regular session at least <u>once</u> every THREE (3) months on a date to be fixed at the first meeting of the Board each year".
- 9) By striking out section #15 and the following substituted: #15) "The Recreation Board shall prepare and submit in writing to the Council a detailed report of the preceding fiscal year activities by the 31st of January".

10) By striking out subsection #16(C)
